"[...] TERRITORIES" is a transmedia exhibition that showcases interactive projects at the **intersection of art, science, and technology**. Each edition explores a distinct theme: Last year's "[LUDIC] TERRITORIES" laid the foundation, while this year's "[ARTIFICIAL] TERRITORIES" **focuses on artificial intelligence.**

At [LUDIC] TERRITORIES, visitors were invited to touch, play, and co-create, transforming the experience into an immersive, collaborative journey. This playful ethos, summed up by our motto **"Ludic instead of obedient,"** proved that audience participation can elevate art beyond mere observation.

Building on that success, [ARTIFICIAL] TERRITORIES is an exhibition exclusively **dedicated to interactive works**, but also welcoming submissions that integrate AI, whether as the primary medium or as a tool. While AI-generated or AI-assisted art often repurposes pre-existing material, raising significant ethical and copyright concerns, we also see **AI as a democratizing force** that can broaden creative expression or serve as a "hackable" resource. **We invite artists to critique, embrace, or subvert AI's role.**
